

Board Meeting Summary

The GoTriangle Board of Trustees met Wednesday, Feb. 24, to consider an agenda that included the following highlights.

Service on Routes 311 and NRX remains suspended

The board approved the suspension of Routes 311 and NRX and gave GoTriangle President/CEO Charles Lattuca the authority to determine when routes would resume normal service.

As part of the response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Routes 311 and NRX have been suspended since March 30, 2020. Although all other GoTriangle routes resumed service in June 2020, Routes 311 and NRX remained suspended in anticipation of very low ridership due to continued work-from-home policies in place at employment locations within Research Triangle Park, which is the transit market that both routes serve.

Board approves continued design for Raleigh Union Station Bus Facility Project

The board authorized an addendum to the predevelopment agreement with Hoffman & Associates – the preferred developer for the Raleigh Union Station Bus Facility Project – to continue to fund the design process.

Nicknamed RUSBus, the facility will be on the ground floor of a private mixed-use development adjacent to Raleigh Union Station in downtown Raleigh. To date, 30 percent design has been completed on the facility. The addendum will allow for design to continue through the interim/Administrative Site Review phase with a focus on advancing the permitting process with the City of Raleigh.
